<u>Support is Available</u>

You maybe contacted by your child's class teacher if your child's attendance falls below 92%. Please remember that this is to support and help your child to attend school regularly. Through these conversations we will be able to work as a team to improve your child's access to learning.

To establish good relationships with others and make progress with their learning, children must attend school regularly. We understand that we have had several cases of childhood illnesses across the school already this term and that this has affected attendance. However, we have also had children absent due to holidays being taken in term time. We would therefore ask again that you consider taking holidays and making routine medical appointments outside the school term if at all possible.

By the time a child has missed 10% of learning time it will be very difficult for that lost learning to be caught up.
