Geography:

We will recap the worlds seven continents and five oceans. We will learn about the equator in relation to hot and cold places.

We will being to explire the questions

What is a coastline?

What do we know about coastlines, including our own?

Can we identify the key features of a coastline?

<u>What makes some places sacred to believers?</u> We will learn about special places people go to worship, and talk about what people do there. We will explore stores, objects, symbols and actions used in churches, mosques and/ or synagogues to show what people believe.

Rights and Responsibilities

We will be learning about how to look after ourselves and our environment at school and at home. We will explore things that help settle and calm us in the classroom.

Music:

How does Music teach us about looking after the planet?

We will be 'Exploring Improvisation'. We will do this through classroom activities and discussions, while

continuing to work implicitly with all the other Foundational Elements of Music.

<u>Computing:</u>

We will be learning about internet safety and continuing to work on using technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

<u>Science:</u>

Living things and their habitats.

We will be exploring and comparing the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will learn about habitats and how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals. We will describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

<u>PE</u>

We will be working on our jumping, focusing on jumps in combination and link jumps. Our second sessions will focus on health and wellbeing. This will look at agility, balance and co-ordination.

<u>Art:</u>

We will use artists such as Hokusai and William Turner as inspiration for our own wave-themed painting.

Design and technology:

We will use our outdoor learning sessions to explore structures. We will plan, design, evaluate and build our own mini village.
