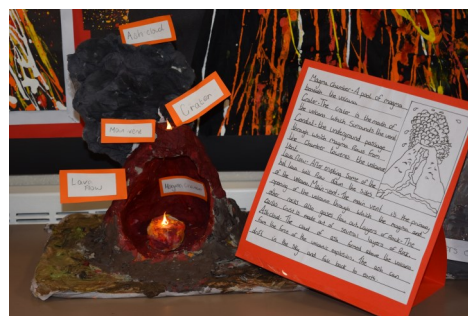
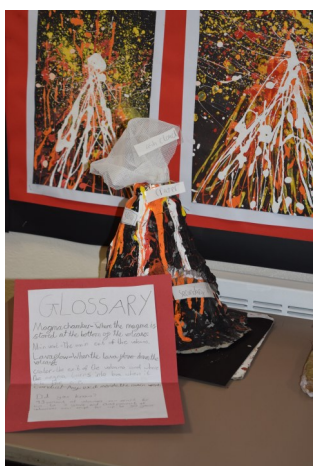
None of the classes reached the 95% attendance target this week.
