The challenge involves climbing the peaks of Snowdon in Wales, Scar Fell Pike in the Lake District and Ben Nevis in Scotland—a distance of 23 miles of walking, ascending over 3km in height, with car travel in between aiming to complete all 3 ascents within 24 hours.

He is raising money to fund sports equipment for school and has so far raised over £1,100!
