

What is the EYFS?


Early Years Foundation Stage

7 Areas of Learning




Prime Areas of Learning

Specific Areas of Learning




Characteristics of Effective Teaching and Learning (CoETL)

I explore and plan my ideas.


Playing and Exploring

I make independent choices.


