Please come along and cheer the children on—it will be a fun day!

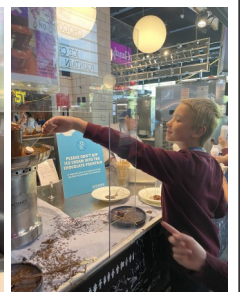


## Year 6 Bristol residential
