Muck, Mess and Mixtures!

<u>Hook</u>

A Messy Morning!

We will hold a messy mixtures morning. Allowing the children to experience a variety of weird and wonderful mixtures that they can feel with their hands and feet. Create messy mixtures from cornflour and water, paint, jelly, shaving foam, body lotion, soap flakes and clay. Allow the children to ladle, pour, touch and explore with their senses.

Art and design:

We will be learning to use observation skills to draw self portraits. We will be learning to print with a range of soft and hard materials to make simple prints. We will be exploring sculpture using 'Barbara Hepworth' as inspiration.

<u>Computing:</u>

We will be learning to log on, find information, retrieve and save files.

<u>English:</u>

Fiction—The Three Little Pigs.

Non Fiction—Recount and Information texts.

<u>Geography:</u>

<u> Place Knowledge</u>

We will learn about physical and human features of our local area. We will use maps, aerial photographs and begin to use and understand map symbols. We will use positional language and directional language and we will begin to learn about the compass points.

<u>PE:</u>

Striking and Fielding

We will be learning to throw and catch balls over various distances, aim accurately, hit a ball with a bat and begin to use our skills to play a game.

Music:

We will be exploring the question 'How Does Music Help Us to Make Friends?'. We will explore simple rhythmic and melodic patterns, pitch, tempo and to sing simple chants and songs,

<u>Science:</u>

Can we help the Three Little Pigs build a new home?

We will be learning to identify and name every day materials and to be able to distinguish between an object and the materials it is made from. To find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching and compare the suitability of materials for a particular use.

<u>RE:</u>

We will be exploring the question: <u>Who do Christians believe created the world?</u> We will explore the creation story, we will think about what the story tells Christians about God, Creation and the world. We will also be finding out about Diwali and Harvest.

PSHE—Me and My relationships

We will be learning about how we contribute positively to classroom life and how everyone has different ways of expressing their feelings.

Outdoor Learning:

We will be exploring materials through exploration. We will be printing, leaf bashing, building towers, bridges and ramps.
