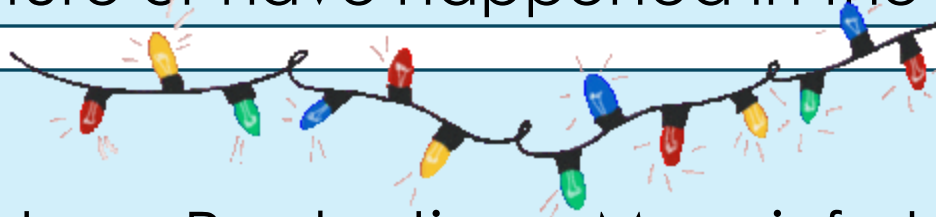


Term 2 – Autumn

Term 3 – Spring

Who is hiding in the woods?

We will be looking at and investigating some traditional tales.

In Science we will be investigating using our senses and naming the different body parts and their functions.

We will look at special stories from different religions in RE and we will be looking at how we can keep safe in PSHE.



Term 4 – Spring

Where in the world?

In Geography we will be looking at the continents and learning to name and identify them. We will look at which animals can be found in which continent.

In Science we will be identifying and classifying animals according to their characteristics.

We will also be learning about rights and respect in PSHE and will be continuing our phonics with RWI.



Term 5 – Summer

How does your garden grow?

In Science we will be exploring plants, growing our own plants and thinking about what they need to grow healthily.

We will be talking about the weather in Geography and linking this to what we have learnt about the seasons throughout the year.

We will be learning about Judaism in RE and will be talking about being our best self in PSHE.



Term 6

Where could the waves take us?

We will be continuing to look at the changing seasons in Science, spending lots of time in the sunshine!

In History we will be finding out about Grace Darling and why we remember her today.
